Rambling rose

A refurbished traditional farmhouse standing on the edge of the village of Kiddington



Where: Kiddington, Oxfordshire.

What: A rambling five bedroom 18th century farmhouse with later additions set in private grounds of over five acres. A smallish house in North Oxford or a rambling Cotswold farm house for the same money – take your pick!

Inside: There are four double bedrooms and an attic bedroom for restoration, four elegant reception rooms, large kitchen and large utility/store rooms. There are original flagstones on the ground floor that show the patina of age and give character and style to the rooms, high ceilings, a

farmhouse-style kitchen, working shutters and huge bedrooms.

Outside: The garden is private, lawned with a wildflower area and former orchard. The jewel in the crown for many though is the five-acre paddock that runs down to the beautiful valley. There are also original stone stables.

How much: £1.2 million.
