

Regency villa

Where: Summertown, Oxford.

What: A classic Regency Villa built in 1840 by Charles Shillingford – an innovative architect of the Late Regency period. The interior has been largely untouched for the last 30 years and is one of the few large detached houses in Oxford that is still a single home with grounds of just under an acre.

Living space: Ground floor comprises conservatory, unique library with ornate glass roof, three further reception rooms and a whole service wing for kitchens,

larders, flower rooms and laundry. Upstairs there is a near-perfect 1930s art deco bathroom.
