TWO recently-built homes on the edge of the Oxford are now available to rent.

The properties in South Hinksey have easy access to the Oxford ring road and city centre.

The Stone House, which was completed six months ago, has a gated courtyard.

An unusually shaped house, it has two reception areas — a light living room and a large fitted kitchen/breakfast room with appliances.

There are three good-sized bedrooms, a bathroom on the

first floor and a boarded attic that offers useful storage space.

The house benefits from underfloor heating on the ground floor.

The rear garden is laid to lawn and there are parking spaces in the communal courtyard.

Stone House is available to rent at £1,350 pcm.

The other property is Geldale House, which is larger and has never been occupied.

Standing in a converted farmyard, the accommodation is arranged over three floors.

On the ground floor there is a living room and a kitchen/dining room/garden room with fitted units and appliances.

and two further bedrooms and a bathroom on the second floor.

Geldale House is available to rent at £1,900 pcm.
